

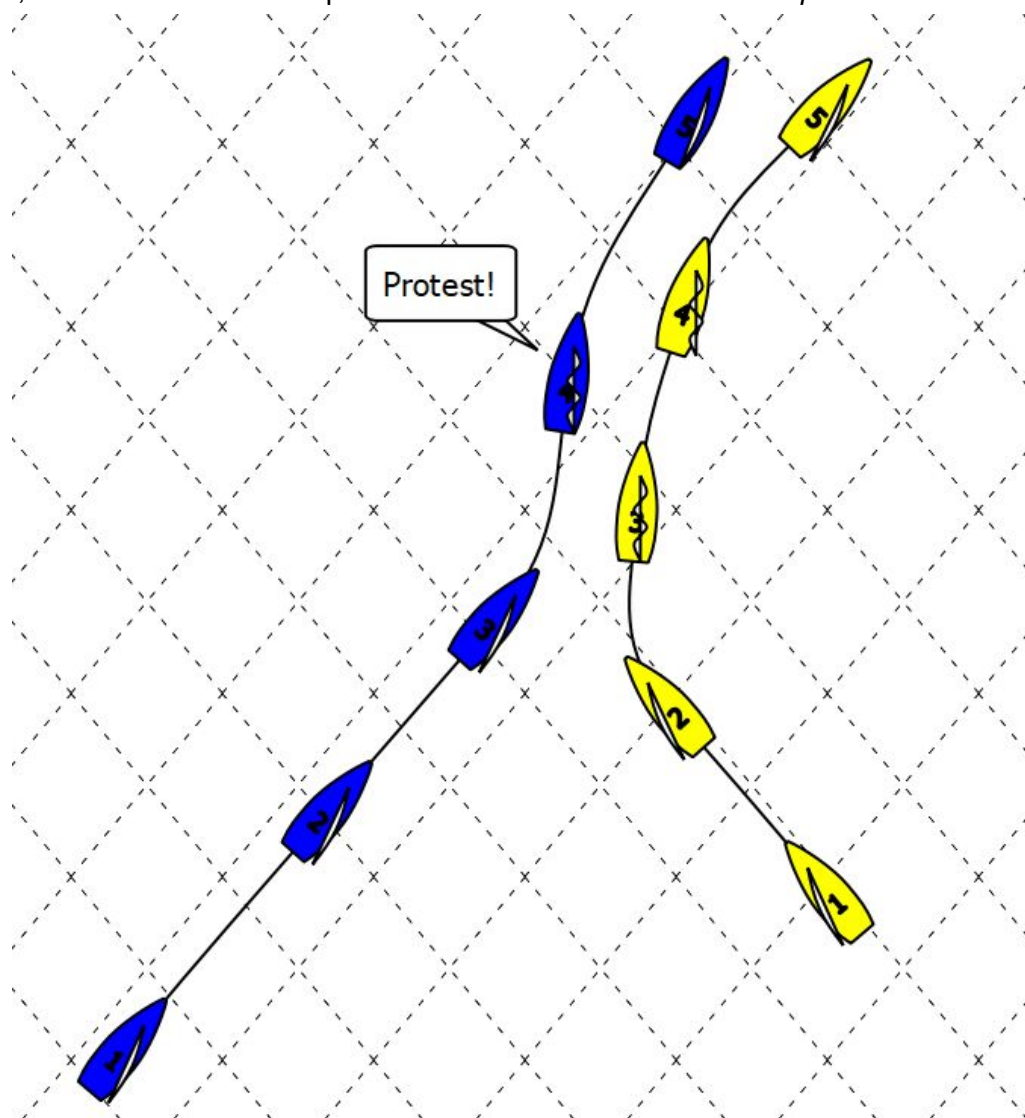
SECTION A

RIGHT OF WAY

A boat has right of way over another boat when the other boat is required to **keep clear** of her. However, some rules in Sections B, C and D limit the actions of a right-of-way boat.

13 WHILE TACKING

After a boat passes head to wind, she shall *keep clear* of other boats until she is on a close-hauled course. During that time rules 10,11 and 12 do not apply. If two boats are subject to this rule at the same time, the one on the other's port side or that one astern shall *keep clear*.



In the diagram yellow becomes a tacking boat at position 3 and fails to keep clear of blue.
